## Sutton and East Surrey

Review should look at;

- Variable support/tariffs regarding income and usage, based on high meter penetration to support those who aren't quite eligible for WaterSure but are still struggling with genuine affordability issues maybe consider tiered caps based on tired eligibility.
- DWP warm referral process to unlock all other support (including non-financial support) they are entitled to from the start point of affordability journey, inclusive of other government schemes/processes that would identify eligibility.
- Hard to reach information and insights from other key stakeholders working in the poverty areas and share learnings/joint up processes.
